Gina was imported by the stud in 1999 along with seven other performance mares and the stallion Collins. She is one of the stud's best producers of elegant, graceful and talented movers and jumpers. She has produced a number of colts and a filly that all have both cadence and jumping ability. These progeny have been sold to FEI Dressage and FEI Showjumping riders in Australia.

DAM PEDIGREE AND BACKGROUND

On her dam's side Wolga's grandsire is the stallion Farnese who was known as an improvement sire for the Holstein breed. He sired many outstanding offspring in Europe in the 1960's and 70's and was the most important of all sires with an imposing frame, strong neck, and good shoulder and back. He sired 15 approved Sons and 194 approved daughters.

Gina is by the Holstein dressage stallion Loutano from Fantus / Carneval. The versatile maternal line 3558 has produced the showjumping stallions such as Littorio and Candillo by Cassini I and the famous KWPN (Holstein) dressage champion stallion Flemmingh ridden by Anky Van Grunsen.

SIRE PEDIGREE AND BACKGROUND

Loutano completed the Stallion Performance Test in 1988 in Adelheidsdorf, placing 3rd out of 72 with a score of 136.63. Loutano received scores of 134.79 (4) for his incredible rideability and 122.31 (10) for jumping.

Loutano is the son and at the same time great-grand son to the incredible hereditary transmitter of showjumping, Landgraf I. The combination with Calypso I completes the image of a top modern sire with versatile heredity. Of all the Ladykiller sons, Landgraf I was able to assert himself the best. At this time, he is the most successful sire of show jumpers the world has seen. He has produced 130 approved stallion sons, who are active in every breed association in Germany and many of Europe and the US' breeding associations. The Holstein breeding association in Elmshorn created a life-sized monument to him in 1994, which was attended personally by Landgraf. Landgraf I died at the age of 30 in 1996. His impact on warmblood breeding will be known for generations yet to come. He is truly an important consideration in any pedigree.

Loutano was the Reserve Champion of the 1990 Holsteiner approvals because of his type and movement and also because of his deviation from the ideals of conformation. Following many wins in conformation classes, Loutano competed successfully in the Federal German Riding Horse Championships in Munich 1991 where he placed 3rd in the final for three year olds.

Loutano's predisposition for dressage enabled him to attain continued success within the discipline. Margit Otto Crepin has had international dressage success with Loutano at the Grand Prix Level. In 1998 the pair placed 4th place at the Grand Prix Special in Beck located in the Netherlands.

In the 2000 FN breeding value rating Loutano was listed among the top 20 of showjumpers in his age class. Loutano has so far produced more than 10 approved sons including Lorentin and Lothringer.

Loutano has registered more than ten approved sons.
