Ciara is the dam of the stallion Buccaneer I currently owned and ridden by Neil Ozanne.

DAMPEDIGREE AND BACKGROUND

Ciara is out of Noblewood Park Julia, a mare by the stallion Jadalco. Jadalco was purchased by Noblewood Park Stud (formerly Yetar Springs Stud) in Belgium. His sire Fabio I has as a grand-sire the foundation stallion of Holsteiner breeding Farnese. From Fabio I's dam side he has the world class stallion Ramiro, sire of many performance horses.

Jadalco's dam Ladalca is by Landgraf I who has been described as the "Stallion of the Century" in Germany. For many years he has been in the top 10 Stallion lists in Germany. Ladalca has the Selle Francais Cor de la Bryere as her dam's sire. Corde has produced numerous world class sport horses. Jadalco has been described by the Dekstation Suls-holsteinhoeve as "A stallion with noble bearing, supple and elastic movement and for us and our breeders the sire of dream foals."

Jadaclo has sired many sport horses in Europe, Australia and now the USA and they are sought after for their type, temperament, movement and jump. Many of them have gone onto compete successfully in dressage, jumping and eventing. Jadalco was campaigned in Australia by Vicki Roycroft and in 1999 was sold to the USA.

Ciara's dam Noblewood Park Julia is out of Barrabadeen Hailey. Hailey was by the imported German stallion Talisman and out of the imported German mare, Heini. Talisman was imported by Mr Van Helvoort of Barrabadeen in Gidgegannup. Van Helvoort imported two stallions, Talisman and Widfeuer as well as eight mares in 1977. Talisman was the winner of his Verband Performance test in 1975. He was a large framed sire that crossed well to thoroughbred mares. He produced many top level jumpers and is still an influential broodmare sire today, particularly in Western Australia. He died in 1998.

SIRE PEDIGREE AND BACKGROUND

Ciara's sire is Collins, a beautiful dark brown jumping stallion born in 1995 in Germany and imported as a three year old in 1998 by the Stud. In April 2000 Collins began his jumping career in Australia. During his inaugural year, and at the age of five years, he firmly made his mark on the local show-jumping scene jumping and winning classes at 1.35m. He campaigned successfully in the Eastern States of Australia in the latter part of 2001 winning many futurities and mini Grand Prix's.

Collins is by the Holsteiner stallion Calando I (by Cor de la Bryère) out of a Caletto I mare (by Cor de la Bryère) giving him a double cross with the famous Holsteiner foundation sire. He is typical of the new type of sport horse currently favoured. He is a well-balanced stallion of 16.3 hands with generous strides and a natural elastic movement. He has a lovely head carried on a beautiful neck, producing elegance, lightness and self-carriage.


