

# Mare - Chanel

### COLLINS X CORIANDER X LORD

Australian Holsteiner Mare Stamm 766 DOB 2000 Breeder: Noblewood Park Stud, Gidgegannup Owner: Noblewood Park Stud, Gidgegannup

Out of the famous State Premium imported mare Cadence (Halla) from the 776 mother and full sister to the stallion Cougar.

#### DAMS PEDIGREE AND BACKGROUND

Chanel's dam is Cadence. Cadence is by the famous dressage stallion Coriander and out of a Lord mare, Doreen I a State Premium mare. She was purchased at the Holsteiner Verband Auction/Classification in August 1998 and was one of the highest priced mares that year.

Coriander is probably best known and respected for producing the quietest minds in Holstein. He ranked as the leading sire of sporthorses for all of Germany in his age group three years in a row. He'll produce elastic movers with deep and effective shoulders. Coriander is included in this elite list of stallions for his consistent production of stallion sons and approved daughters. His pedigree speaks highly of the successes of this stallion. Sire Coriolan is from the first foal crop of Calypso II. Coriander himself is from the first foal crop of Coriolan.

Even though in his stallion performance test Coriander showed exceptional talent as a jumper, it was apparent that he was even more suited for dressage. He was trained first by H. Peter Mohr, then went on to show under Wolfgang Schade for the Holsteiner Verband, through International Grand Prix. Coriander has produced many State Premium mares and 7 approved stallion sons, including Cappucino, Carlino (purchased by Margit Ott-Crepin), and others. Coriander is known for producing very rideable horses with exceptional movement.

Coriander is included in this elite list of stallions for his consistent production of stallion sons (7 approved) and approved daughters (5 State premium mares). Chanel's full brother Cougar won Supreme Champion at the Holsteiner Classifications in February 2002 at the unprecedented age of six months. (NB: Famous Holsteiner Stamm 776 has produced sires such as Calvados I and II, Cortino I and II, Lord Incipit, Captain Incipit, Lauritz J, Rossini, Acorado, Lordanos, Ramirado Contiki, Toledo, and world-class sire Ramiro, who is present in many top showjumping horses and sires).

#### SIRES PEDIGREE AND BACKGROUND

Chanel is by the outstanding imported German stallion Collins, out of the imported Holsteiner mare Cadence from the well-known Stamm 776. Collins was born in 1995 in Germany and imported in 1998 by the Noblewood Park Stud. In April 2000 Collins started his jumping career. During his inaugural year, and at age five years, he firmly made his mark on the local show-jumping scene, winning classes up to 1.50m. He campaigned successfully in the Eastern States of Australia in the latter part of 2001 winning a number of futurities and mini Grand Prix. In the same year he was awarded the supreme title of Horse of the Year, a title which he successfully defended the following year. In 2003 Collins was selected for the Australian Showjumping talent squad, becoming the youngest horse on the squad and was then exported back to Germany where he was selected as Reserve Horse for the 2003 Australian Team Olypmic Qualification event at Aachen. Collins is by the Holsteiner stallion Calando I (by Cor de la Bryère) out of a Caletto II mare (by Cor de la Bryère) giving him a double cross with the famous Holsteiner foundation sire.

He is typical of the new type of sport horse currently favoured. He is a well-balanced stallion of 16.3 hands with generous strides and a natural elastic movement. He has a lovely head carried on a beautiful neck, producing elegance, lightness and self-carriage.
