

## Mare - Rolanda

Rolanda is an important addition to the stud by the stallion Capo with the Selle Francais stallion Alme Z featuring on the dam line. Capo is Calotta's full brother and Rolanda will be an important addition to the Noblewood breeding program.

## Sire's Pedigree

Capo's sire Calando I, was sold into showjumping after a three year covering stint and became a real hit. He became German Champion in 1984 under Karsten Huck and in the very same year managed to get placements in Rome, Dublin and the Calgary Grand Prix'. Thereafter, under E H Cupper of Belgium, he achieved countless further international successes.

Capo's dam Ozol is the full sister of the sire Libero who was also very successful show jumper. Capo is also the full brother to our imported mare Calotta.

Calotta was a consistent winning at Grand Prix level and has placed highly in World Cup Qualifiers including a 2nd and 3rd placing in 2005. Calotta was the winner of the World Cup Warm-up at Equitana in 2004 when Noblewood had a 1st, 2nd and 4th placing in the one event and Blatini went on to win the World Cup the following day. She was Horse of the in 2004 (Western Australia) and 4th in the Australian Championships in 2004 (Mount Gambier). She won the Countryman Cup and the prestigious Wodonga Futurity in 2002.

## Dam's Pedigree

Rolanda's maternal grandsire is the legendary Acord II coming from Alme Z. Acord II's progeny have won over a quarter of a million euros, with 327 jumpers who have placed in competition, and 47 dressage horses. As of 2003, Acord II has an FN jumping ranking of 143, as against his dressage ranking of 106. The Hannoverian Stallion book for 2003 records that on the basis of mare tests and auction evaluations, he has a jumping score of 149. Acord II is out of Ribecka, who was a champion mare in Holstein.

Mandarin in the fourth line of her pedigree is out of Holle, who was also the grand-dam of Ramiro. Mandarin's daughter Urbine is the grand-dam of the international jumper and supersire, Burggraaf. Ribecka was by one of the most influential sons of Cor de la Bryère, Calypso I. Acord II has produced more than 40 stallion sons, one of the more famous is Broere VDL Atlantic, who was the Six Year Old Jumping Champion at the 1999 Bundeschampionate with Ulrich Kirchhoff.
